(1) Roll Call -

(2) Ordinance -

• Ordinance 2022-33- AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE FINAL SUBDIVISION PLAT OF THE PINES PHASE 3 SUBDIVISION, CREATING RESIDENTIAL LOTS 99-135, CITY OF CENTERTON, S20-T20N-R31W, BENTON COUNTY, ARKANSAS.

Mayor Edwards addressed the Council, stating that this Ordinance is to accept the Final Plat of the Pines Phase 3 Subdivision. He said this subdivision is off Walters Road, and there are 36 Lots. He said the Warranty Bonds have been received, as presented in the Ordinance. He said this item was recommended for City Council Approval by the Planning Commission on April 19th, 2022.
